#### Investment focus

The fund's aim is to achieve capital growth in the long term, is actively managed and invests in global healthcare companies with innovative business models. Its investment universe consists of biotechnology and pharma companies, medical technology and services companies as well as generics producers that are involved in the development, manufacturing or sale of products and services. Experienced sector specialists focus on profitable companies that have a well-established product portfolio. The fund invests top down in the four regions North America, Western Europe, Emerging Markets and Japan/Oceania. For each of these regions, the most attractive companies are determined based on quantitative and qualitative criteria. The fund seeks to outperform the MSCI World Healthcare Index. The fund takes ESG factors into consideration while implementing the aforementioned investment objectives.

#### Market review

Global equities continued to recover in June 2025, with the MSCI World Index ending the month up 4.3%. While remaining a laggard, healthcare also started recovering (MSCI World Healthcare up +1.4%) from what had been a significant (perhaps peak) level of fear around US drug pricing reform in May. The Bellevue Healthcare Strategy (LUX) Fund (I-shares: +2.0%, in USD) outperformed its healthcare index benchmark by 58 bps.

US President Trump released an Executive Order (EO) calling for most-favored-nation (MFN) drug pricing on May 12. This called for the HHS to propose drug price targets within 30 days, with the industry being given 180 days to show signs of progress. Alongside this, there remains the 232 investigation on pharmaceuticals related to national security and potential tariffs. We are therefore within the middle of these two processes, with a lack of clear direction at present. The potential for a pilot program around MFN appears to have waned. In addition, we have not seen MFN enter the reconciliation bill (big beautiful bill) negotiations in congress. This lack of information and slowing momentum, has provided a support to pharmaceutical valuations.

Beyond US politics, June was a busy month of healthcare conferences. Early in the month we attended the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) annual meeting in Chicago. During the meeting we gained a growing picture of the potential new modalities and mechanisms that are emerging in early/mid-stage studies (ADCs, bispecifics etc.). Later in June, we attended the American Diabetes Association (ADA) conference. This year's ADA spotlighted the next generation of obesity and metabolic therapies. Oral GLP-1 alternatives, muscle-sparing regimens, and combination hormone therapies all gained traction, pointing toward a maturing market still rich in unmet needs. Across both therapeutic areas, we have been impressed by the innovation now coming from China, including some of the stocks we hold in our portfolio.

#### **Positioning & outlook**

We expect the current uncertainty surrounding US healthcare related policy to moderate as more details emerge. While the EO stated all branded drugs, it is likely that this will need to be narrowed to specific government channels, especially in the context of a pilot study. We also see the potential for the 232 investigation scope to be narrowed, perhaps exclusively in China which do actually hold a national security risk (antibiotics and lbuprofen, for example). In the coming months, we could see this also acting as a clearing event for the biopharma. We therefore expect the final outcome of MFN and tariffs will be less damaging on future company earnings than feared.

#### **General description**

The investment process for the Bellevue Healthcare Strategy (Lux) Fund resembles the rules-based investment process that Bellevue has applied since 2007. In this approach, the 45 most attractive stocks in the healthcare sector worldwide are selected every six months. The Bellevue Healthcare team screens about 600 of the 5000 listed companies in the healthcare sector worldwide based on four quantitative criteria (PEG valuation, price/sales, sales growth and EBITDA/sales) and four qualitative criteria (assessing the company's management, product pipeline, operating risks and country related risks). The most promising stocks from four different regions – Western Europe (10 stocks), North America (15 stocks), Japan/Australia (10 stocks) and emerging markets (10 stocks) – are selected. The weighting per region (North America: 45%, Western Europe: 25%, Japan/Australia: 15%, and emerging markets in the MSCI World Healthcare Index, we are inherently overweight this region.
