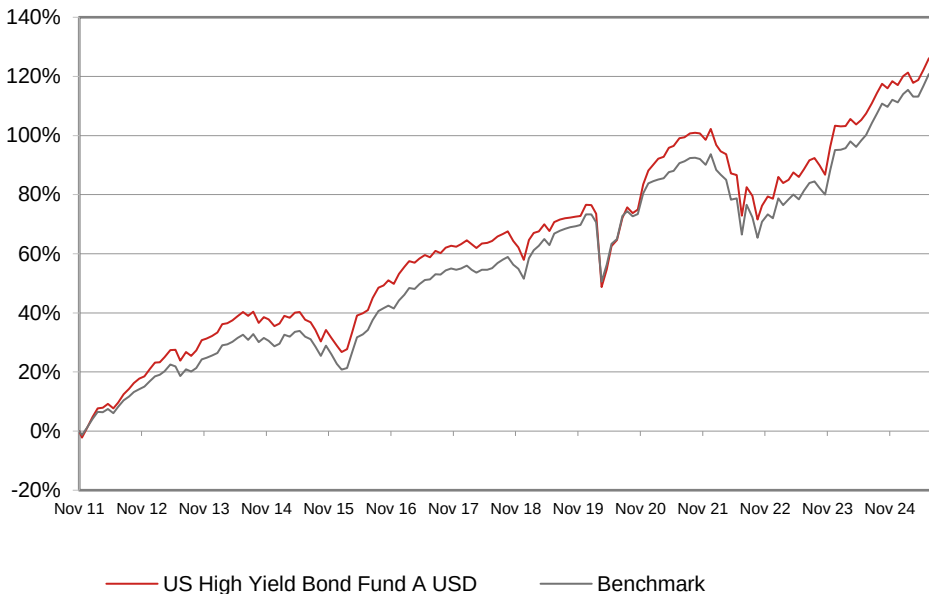


INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

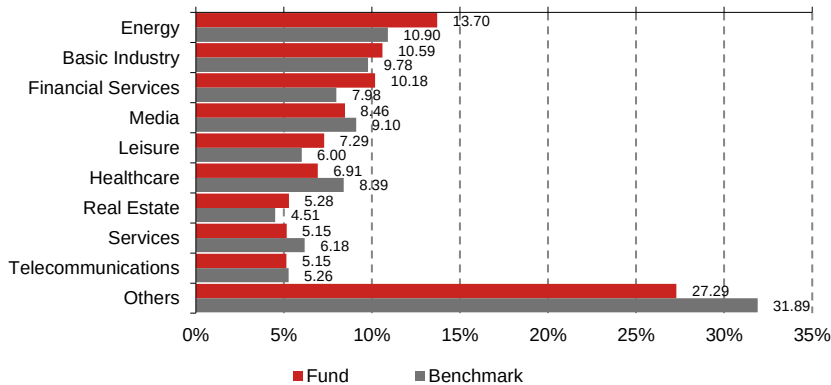

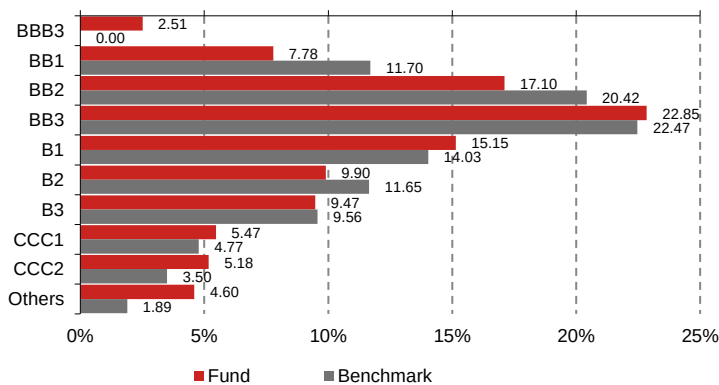
